



To make your very own
shamrock brooch,
simply cut out each shamrock
and layer,
adding a drop of glue in the middle of each
shamrock as you layer.

(I used hot glue which gives almost instant re-
sults. You can use Elmer's glue, but the drying
time will be about an hour)

Make sure you layer Largest on the bottom,
smallest on top.

Once layers are dry, starting at smallest layer,
simply fold up each shamrock just a little for a
3-d effect.

Add a little safety pin on the back by piercing
the middle of the upper back most shamrock.
Do this before you start embellishing.

Then have fun dipping a small paintbrush in
glue, painting glue on to shamrocks, and
adding glittery embellishments
